

Organization Meeting Report

Centralization of Federation Employment

April 19th [1934]

Attendance The following institutions were represented at this meeting, which was called by Mr. Frederick W. Greenfield, Chairman of the Committee Sponsoring Centralization:

Procedure Mr. Greenfield, as Chairman of the Sponsoring Committee, occupied the chair, and announced that each institution would be privileged to cast one vote on all votable issues that would arise at this meeting. The following institutions through their representatives went on record as committed to all decisions arrived at in the course of this meeting:

Young Men's Hebrew Association
Hebrew Orphan Asylum
Jewish Board of Guardians
Nation Council of Jewish Women,
New York Section

The Emanuel Federated Employment Service indicated that its Board of Directors had not as yet reached a decision with regard to continued interest in and relationship with centralization.

Decisions The following motions were duly seconded and passed:

- (1) A provisional board of directors be set up to consist of two representatives of each of the cooperating institutions, and at least one of these representatives shall be a member of the board of directors of the cooperating institution.
- (2) The name of the projected central bureau shall be THE FEDERATION EMPLOYMENT SERVICE.
- (3) Mr. Irwin Rosen shall be appointed to the post of provisional executive director.
- (4) Three members-at-large shall be appointed to the provisional board of directors of the new bureau, such members to be unaffiliated with any of the cooperating institutions.
